HEADQUARTERS

Cirencester Town Football Ground (the Corinium Stadium), Kingshill Lane, Cirencester
([CLICK HERE](#) for full details and a map), which will be open from around 7.00 am.
Toilets, changing rooms and showers are available at the headquarters.

Parking: There should be sufficient parking space providing you park sensibly.

SIGNING ON / NUMBERS

Read any notices displayed on the table relating to safety issues on the day before signing on.

Race numbers will be available on signing on the HQ from approximately 7.00 am onwards.

Please ensure that the numbers are exchanged for light refreshments after the event.

Allow minimum of around 20 minutes from HQ to start line and sign on at least 30 minutes before your race time.

SAFETY

In the interests of safety, Cycling Time Trials and the Las Vegas Institute of Sport, organisers of this event strongly advise you wear a hard shell safety helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. This is mandatory in the case of any riders 18 years of age and under.

Riders attention is also drawn to CTT regulations in particular:

- No 19 - Observance of the law
- No 20 - Paced riding and company riding
- No 21 - Use of motor vehicles

Riders must shout out their number when passing the finish line and should not under any circumstances approach the Timekeeper during the event.

The current Course Risk Assessment document will be on display at the HQ. Please also read and specifically note the "On the day course risk assessment" plus any other safety notice at the HQ.

GETTING TO THE START

Turn right out of the gateway to the HQ and proceed down the hill to the T-junction where, with extreme caution, turn left on to the A419. Continue to the roundabout / junction that would take you down onto the A419 dual carriage, the start of the course is at the top of this sliproad just as you come off the roundabout (1st exit) - approximately 2.5 miles from the HQ.

Allow at least 20 minutes to get from the HQ to the start.

COURSE DETAILS – U47

Please note that due to safety concerns the 'new' U47 course is no longer available to use, therefore all events are reverting to the course used in 2007 – see details below.

Start at the top top of the slip road onto the A419 towards Swindon just off the Airfield Roundabout (OS Ref. 061992). Proceed down the sliproad to join the A419 dual carriageway southbound.

Leave dual carriageway at Cricklade and cross the flyover, at first roundabout take the 2nd exit (straight over) and continue to 2nd roundabout. **Turn at 2nd roundabout** and retrace to 1st roundabout and take 1st exit to rejoin A419 northbound (signposted for Cirencester). Continue on this road past the spine road junction until the South Cerney / Cirencester Industrial Estate junction (opposite the start) where you leave the A419. The finish is on this slip road approximately 50 metres before roundabout (GR 062991). Total course distance - 10 miles.

Please note: This is a course change from the course used earlier this year, and for safety reasons has reverted to the 2007 course. The onus is on the rider to know the course.

No U-turns are permitted near to the start or finish areas. After the finish, riders should continue on and return to the race HQ.

No warming up on the course after the first rider has started.
